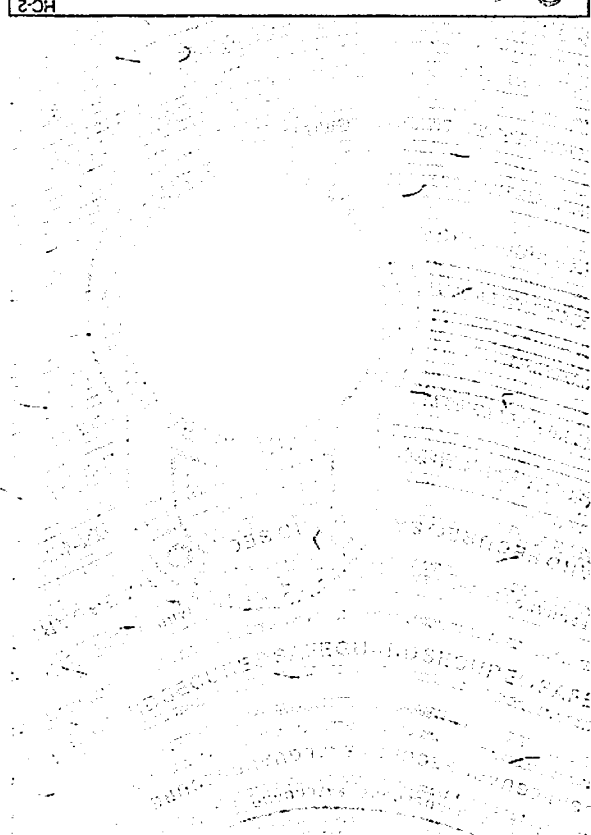

The security features listed below, as well as those not listed, exceed industry guidelines.

Security Features:

- Hologram:**
 - Foil seal with multi-dimensional images fused to check stock cannot be photocopied.
 - Responds to various head reads between thumb and forefinger or brodie on it. The image will flip and respond.
- True Watermark:**
 - Hold check to a light source to view, cannot be photocopied.
 - Visible fibers randomly embedded in the paper.
- Visible Fibers:**
 - Fluorescent fibers in paper are visible under ultraviolet light.
- Check Background Pattern:**
 - Unique background pattern of security features.
 - Stars or specks may appear throughout the pattern.
- Chemistry Sensitive Paper:**
 - Stains or spots appear when photocopied attempts are made.
- Microprinting:**
 - Small type appears as dotted line when photocopied.
 - Alerts handler the document contains security features.
- Warning Band:**
 - Chemistry in paper bands used to alert paper fibers with heat. Damage visible with ultraviolet attempts.
- Toner Addressed Reports:**
 - Any stain or discoloration in this area may indicate attempted fraud or a transaction.
- Chemical Wash Detection Areas:**
 - Discourages out-of-pocket alterations.
- Limit Two Backed:**
 - Predicted design is a certification mark of the Check Payment Systems Association.
